Know Your 2017 Dental Plan Options

It is important to note that benefit coverage levels vary by plan, depending on the dental plan option you choose for 2017 and which type of dentist you use. SCL Health offers two Dental Plan Options:

1. **Delta Dental Choice Plan**
2. **Delta Dental Core Plan**

Prevention First

Regular visits to the dentist can improve your overall health. With **Prevention First**, diagnostic and preventive services like exams, X-rays and cleanings **do not count against your annual maximum plan coverage – as long as you stay in network for all claims** – which allows you to stretch those dollars. This could be useful if you need additional treatment. So be sure to see a Delta Dental PPO or Premier dentist (depending on your dental plan selected) for a checkup at least once a year!
